PCPA Cheerleader Contract

I. Team Purpose:

- A. Develop responsibility, teach self-respect, encourage honest effort, strive for perfection, and develop character.
- B. Teach teamwork and pride in a quality performance, while maintaining high standards.
- C. Promote friendship and respect with all cheerleaders, coaches, sponsors, and other teams.
- D. Promote interest in school activities and uphold school spirit/conduct.
- E. Cheer for pep rallies, sporting events, and represent the school in cheerleading competitions and showcases.

II. Academic Requirements:

A. All team members must maintain a **GPA of 2.0 and above in all academic classes**. Academic standings will be analyzed individually and monitored periodically. However, please note that cheerleaders can be suspended from games, events, and/or competitions due to academic performance. Cheerleaders will be removed from the team due to low academic performance.

B. Cheerleaders may be removed from the team if they are not to **maintain a 2.5 overall GPA per quarter**.

III. Conduct Requirements:

A. By accepting the privilege / honor of being a Stingray Cheerleader, team members accept the fact that their actions are more prominent than those not associated with such activity. All team members must maintain a **Conduct GPA of 2.0 and above in all academic classes**.

B. Exemplary behavior is required at all times, whether on or off school grounds. This includes, but not limited to, use of crude language, inappropriate behavior, vandalism, etc. This also applies to posts on any social media outlets while on school grounds, school associated events, or wearing any school identifying uniform or cheer uniforms.

C. All rules and regulations found in the Pinecrest Cove Preparatory Academy Student Handbook and Miami-Dade County Code of Student Conduct are also required to be followed.

D. Poor conduct / behavior under any of the above circumstances will result in the following:

1. Verbal warning with team sponsor and/or administration.
2. Suspension from performance, game, and/or competition. The sponsor and administration will make this decision after thorough review of each incident.
3. Removal from the squad. The sponsor and administration will make this decision after thorough review of each incident.

III. Attendance Requirements:

- A. Practices are mandatory, if you are not able to attend a practice make sure to email A1 Athletics and Ms.Sandoval.
- B. Missing practices two weeks prior to a competition could result in losing your spot or removal from the competition.

III. Payment Policy:

- A. All team fees must be paid in full and on time according to the payment schedule provided at registration.
- B. Missed or late payments will incur a late fee of \$25 on the 5th & 16th of each month
- C. Athletes with outstanding balances: Will not receive uniforms, competition entry, or choreography until the balance is paid. And may be suspended from participation until payments are current.
- D. Payments are non-refundable, even if the athlete quits or is removed from the team.

As a cheerleader, you are a representative of Pinecrest Cove. Your academics and behavior (on campus/off campus/on-social media) should be exemplary at all times.
